RESOLUTION

Government is pleased to direct that one day's special casual leave should be granted henceforth to all Government servants (Whether borne on regular cadre or work-charged or daily establishment) who donated blood voluntarily without taking any payment for the same.

2. The grant of such special casual leave should be restricted to not more than 10 days in a year.
3. All medical officers who take blood from the Government servants voluntarily should issue immediately a certificate to that effect and the Head of the Departments and Institutions, etc. should sanction the special casual leave on the authority of such a certificate.
4. These orders issue with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide Finance Departments, Un-official reference No. 1052 IX, dated 8th June, 1965.
